No Dues and Provisional Degree (see Section 12 of PG Manual)

A Ph.D student shall be deemed to have completed the graduation requirements, if the student has,

- 1). Passed all the prescribed courses,
- 2). Attained the minimum required CPI,
- 3). Satisfied the minimum academic and duration requirements,.
- 4). Satisfied all the requirements specified by the concerned department, if any,
- 5). Satisfied all the requirements specified by the Senate and the Ordinances.

In addition, the student should have paid all the dues to the Institute and, should have no pending case of indiscipline.

A Ph.D student fulfilling the above requirements may start the process of obtaining "No Dues" clearance from the Institute.

The student will be awarded the provisional degree after obtaining "No Dues" clearance. Actual degree will be awarded during the Institute Convocation, which is held every year in May-June.
