Post-doctoral vacancies 2021-2022

- 1. **All** applications submitted online are be in the at to portal https://pingala.iitk.ac.in/IITKFR-0/login This is a rolling advertisement and applications can be submitted throughout the year. All the default entries in the online portal have to be satisfied.
- 2. The applicants must be Indian nationals with a Ph.D degree from a reputed institute / university.
- 3. The applications are processed normally twice in a year. The applications received till December 1, 2021 will be considered in this round.
- 4. The cover letter should mention <u>the topic of research, name(s) of preferred mentor(s) at IIT Kanpur, and the names and complete contact details of 3 referees (including the main thesis advisor).</u> The application should contain the full name, present and permanent address, date of birth, full details of educational qualifications, list of journal publications, list of conference publications, and a well thought-out research plan for 2 years. It is a good practice to contact the mentors and find out their willingness before submitting their name.
- 5. <u>The selection will be based on the quality of research work and the quality of publications,</u> <u>IITK mentor's recommendation on the research plan, seminar (skype/in person) if found</u> <u>suitable, and a minimum of two reference letters (only for those short-listed after seminar).</u> <u>Applicants are also expected to have an impeccable academic record borne out by</u> <u>marks/grades in their pre-PhD education.</u>
- 6. Applicants who have recently defended their thesis will be preferred. At any rate, applicants with more than 3 years of post-doctoral experience will not be considered for this call.
- 7. A maximum of one-month time is usually given for joining after announcing the result.
- 8. Post-doctoral position consists of a fellowship of Rs.60,000 per month + 16% of the fellowship amount as HRA for off-campus accommodation + Rs.1,00,000 per year for travel and contingency.
- 9. Each appointment will be made initially for a period of one year, and it may be extended for a second year subject to satisfactory performance.
- The post-doctoral fellows will be encouraged to participate in the departmental teaching activities such as being a tutor or a teaching assistant (with an involvement of a maximum of 8 hours per week) subject to Senate-prescribed conditions.
- 11. Candidates with a Ph.D degree from IIT Kanpur or a thesis advisor from IIT Kanpur or postdoc experience from IIT Kanpur will not be considered for these vacancies.
- 12. Applicants in experimental disciplines are especially encouraged to apply.
